### Minutes

- Infrastructure (FVPs in Tux)
  - TF-A
    - The TF-A release was completed yesterday
    - [\[TFC-742\] github user not able to log in to review.trustedfirmware.org - Jira](#)
      - New issue/ticket
      - Recently changed priority from Minor to Blocker
    - The other issue is the Gerrit server slowness (see details below)
    - [\[TFC-629\] TFC: Minor issues with LTS triage script, also edit the receiver list - Jira](#)
      - In Progress
      - Low priority so Arthur isn't working on it as he's tending to other higher priority tickets
  - TF-M
    - Upcoming TF-M release
      - The trees will be frozen on May 2
      - Hoping to complete the release in the mid-May timeframe
    - The main issue is the Gerrit server slowness (see details below)
    - [\[TFC-731\] Investigate eRPC testing in LAVA - Jira](#)
      - Blocker
      - Matt responded to Karen's comment last week

**NOTE – We don't have any other high priority tickets for TF-A or TF-M at the moment. Karen would like the teams to look into the SC Approved and Backlog to determine what the next tickets to put In Progress and update the ticket priority so Linaro knows which tickets to work on next.**

- Ben
  - Gerrit server issue that came up on the TF slack channel
    - There's an increased load coming from an Arm IP address (217), but we're not sure which team that is
      - **Action** - Sufyan to follow up and try to find out where it's coming from within Arm
    - There's also a bot issue that's also adding to the load
      - Ben cleaned up some of the bots yesterday in the hope it will lessen the load
    - Things Linaro can do to further lessen the load
      - Enable the Anubis tool which acts as a transparent proxy in front of Gerrit; doesn't proxy Git requests
      - Upgrade the server; not usually a hard and fast rule in this case
    - Next steps
      - Wait to hear from Sufyan on where the 217 address is coming from and get an understanding of what they're doing
      - Ben is continuing to lessen the bot load
- Sufyan
  - How does this server issue impact Gerrit for Phase 2 of the Arm Transition Project?
    - Ben said he'd be happy to share his knowledge of Anubis and the team can install it on their side
  - The team will have to decide the best way forward
  - Sufyan said he would like the team to have a sync with Ben
  - Note - The Arm Transition to OpenCI project, Phase 1, is going live the first week of June
