- TF-A and TF-M Releases

  - TF-A is released, depended on the their internal OpenCI.
  - TF-M is trending towards Dec 8th.
- Staging
  - Being used by TF-M for testing. Concert that this is not setup as a performant system.
  - Xinyu Staging CI is use to test TF-M CI patches; or dependencies between patches
  - Stage was updated last thursday and it needed an update IP address.
- MBedTLS
  - The nightlies are running, "reasonably" performant . Per patch still looks slow.
  - Dave could we get more powerful executors, but less of them. Would be good to bump executors first, then lessen the number of executors.
  - Ben would like more numbers over the next few days. Make the change on Friday.
- LTS
  - Joanna, Okash and Bipin met with Paul at Linaro about LTS automation. For advice from Paul work primarily being done by LTS maintainers.

- Licensing free tool chain
  - UBLS evaluation licenses? Is this acceptable?
  - Don added temp licenses email note to TFC-198.
  - Ben is currently full up, this is going to require cycles we do not have right now.
    - Using the ARM license server does not gain much, just the admin of the server.
    - Moving to UBL is costly, would start with an initial pipeline test, thru lava.
    - Will not evaluate UBL by end of year.
  - Short term, we need to current licenses.
    - AI: Shebu/Matteo will go back to Paul Black to extend the current licenses.
      - Note: Shebu reached out to Paul Black for licenses after the meeting.
