## Minutes

- FYI; Ben is on vacation: March 19th - 29th
- Infrastructure (FVPs in Tux)
  - TF-A: Performance is going well
  - TF-M: is in progress; currently working on resolving issues with TF-M and UBL Licensing
- UBL License - Ben working on this
  - UBL is timing out, have not seen any issue since putting in some retry code.
  - Benjamin Copeland has follow-up emails with Paul Black on getting this fixed.
- Releases coming up
  - TF-M work starts end of April;
  - TF-A freezes in mid-May; the infrastructure will be ready in early May when the bulk of the code merge and testing occurs.
- TF-A LTS
  - Joanna: No longer log in to lists.TF.org, getting a server error [TFC-593](#) submitted. The issue is now resolved.
  - Two minor releases, LTS branches. Releases are being tested, and things are under control.
- MBedTLS
  - Things are healthy. Executor changes went through, and things are running faster.
- Ben
