- Holiday schedule
  - o Cancel the 27th, have the next meeting on the 20th
- Release for TF-A and TF-M completed!
  - o One issue, for documentation, low priority
- Mbed TLS
  - Latest Staus
    - BSD nodes broken. Kelley is looking into this. This was broken as of the update to Jenkins. There are issues with JDK version incompatibility.
    - AWS plugin got updated and Jenkins. Both were deployed last thursday.
  - AWS Costs
    - Short term overrun estimate of ~\$6k due to testing
      - April Sept avg \$1166/month Oct \$2200 / Nov \$2800 /
      - Budget \$1200/month
    - Long term Get estimate for long term.
      - There are "fixed" costs nightly runs, and "variable" based on Pull Requests.
      - The current internal is the expected performance level
    - Dave is seeing that the Nightlies have parity; issue with the dailies, PRs.
    - Still can consider spot instances or on demand instances, but this too can impact the performance.
    - Need to get a stable set of days for timing.
    - Sheet Arthur is keeping track of builds, timings and changes to infrastructure.
- Infrastructure Changes/updates (Ben)
  - Request is for a new Server to support MISRA (Scaleway) and an upgrade for Jenkins - Supporting MbedTLS (Scaleway)
  - TF-A/TF-M is already VERY busy and would benefit from addition the server.
  - Don has the budget from the board,
    - ACTION: Glen to create an STG ticket to add another Jenkins Agent added Done <a href="https://linaro.atlassian.net/browse/STG-3919">https://linaro.atlassian.net/browse/STG-3919</a>
  - Upgrade the Jenkins Server upgrade to a higher server. This would have an additional cost of about 100Euros/month.
