### Minute:

- Infrastructure updates from Ben
  - An issue with the Jenkins production server. The server is not as performant as it should be. The issue is when there are many jobs queued up, Jenkins is slow. We see plenty of room (i.e., CPU, mem, etc.) on the back end. Ben & Kelley are looking into it.
- Joanna
  - No infrastructure issues, but some broken builds; they should be fixed now
  - Looking for Paul to help out with some TF-A
- MBedTLS([Spreadsheet](#))
  - Moving Executor sizes for Linux and FreeBSD from T3.large to T3.medium - No change in performance.
  - Next is moving Windows from C4.2xl to a T3.Large - this seemed to add 20 mins to the run
  - Continue to keep running the MbedTLS nightly.
  - PR jobs are sitting for about 90min, within an acceptable performance.
  - Bence is looking at some logging changes that could improve performance.
  - Ben - preparing for cost analysis.
